LANGUAGE STUDIES MINOR

Regulations Governing Minor Course Work

- 1. There shall be a minimum of 18.0 credit hours with a minimum Millersville OPA of 2.0.
- 2. Only one course which counts toward your major may be counted toward your minor.
- Courses that count toward a minor are also eligible to be used to satisfy the current University-wide General Education requirements subject to normal distribution requirements.
- At least two courses should be at the upper-division level (300-400).
 Exceptions may be requested upon evidence of program depth.
- 5. No course needed for the minor may be taken Pass-Fail.
- 6. One-half or more of the work required for the minor must be completed at Millersville University.
- 7. No student may minor in his or her major.

The minor in Language Studies requires declaration of a specific language, we offer French, German, and Spanish.
